The MG TD is a British sports car that was produced from 1949 to 1953. It was a modernised version of the MG TC, with a 4 speed transmission, independent front suspension, and rack & pinion steering.

The engine is a 1489 cc, four-cylinder unit delivering 68 bhp. Despite its age (1950) is easy to drive, with a conventional pedal layout and traditional gearshift pattern.

In Design The TD is 5 inches wider than the TC, with a track of 50 inches and its standard equipment includes bumpers with over-riders plus plump seats give it a sporting feel also enhanced by its lightweight frame

This particular 1950's car has been professionally renovated to an extensive level as can be witnessed by the pictures or better still a personal visit. This includes new interior trim, seats, carpets, dashboard and replacement engine. Naturally the car still retains its originality and oldy worldy appeal and she drives really well

The car is supplied with with new side screens and roof

The renovation is well documented with extensive paperwork and MOT history. Additionally the car has been serviced and matters such as brakes and suspension addressed
